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## Important Notice - You May be Eligible for Up To a \$300 Property Tax Credit

Amendment 79 was passed by majority vote of the people of Arkansas during the statewide General Election on November 7, 2000. Amendment 79 is intended to create property tax relief for homeowners within the State of Arkansas and provides for up to a \$300 tax credit on the property that is their principal place of residence. Answering the following questions will provide your Assessor's Office with the information necessary in order to determine if you qualify for the credit.

A property owner may claim only one property tax credit in the State of Arkansas.

  3. If buying on contract, do you pay the taxes for this property?.....  Yes  No  
(Recorded contracts only are eligible.)

  5. Will you be 65 years of age or older by December 31, 2004?.....  Yes  No  
(If Yes, include a copy of your Arkansas Driver's License or other Proof of Age.)

(If Yes, include a copy of your disability documentation from the Social Security Administration.)
